Student Drivers Guidelines and Permission Form.

These guidelines are issued for those students who have passed their driving test and wish to drive to and from school. This is acceptable and permissible *only* for those in the Sixth Form.

- Students may not drive their cars onto the school grounds.
- Students and parents are advised that it is strongly preferred that school transport is used during the school day for movement between sites.
- Drivers should not give lifts to other students during the course of the day.
- Students should be aware of the considerable insurance implications of ignoring these guidelines.
- It is strongly advised that insurance should cover business use.
- Both parent/guardian and student must sign the attached consent form before returning it to the Sixth Form Administrator.
- Cars should be parked with care and with due consideration for our neighbours. In the interests of safety, when parking at the College site students are required to park in College Road or other areas and to keep College Avenue clear for parents of nursery and infant children.
- Parking outside either site can be difficult. Please allow plenty of time to find a parking space and do not use this as an excuse for being late.
- Experience shows that students with cars tend to be later for school than those without. Please allow plenty of time for the journey taking into account traffic and road conditions. Persistent lateness may lead to the withdrawal of permission to use a car to come to school.
