SECONDARY

AT Claires Court Schools we want Staff and Students to enjoy the sun safely. Working with Staff and Students we hope to achieve this through:-

EDUCATION

- Years 7 – 11 will receive at least one PSHCE sun protection lesson.
- The importance of sun protection will be discussed in assembly at the start of the summer term.
- Staff, Parents and Guardians will be made aware of the Sun Protection Policy and a letter will be sent home at the start of the summer term.

PROTECTION

- Students will be allowed to apply factor 15+ sunscreen in school and will be reminded as and when necessary (although this cannot be guaranteed).
- Sunscreen will be encouraged on school trips where appropriate.
- Students may wear appropriate hats during outside activities.
- Gazebos will be available for use on sports days.
- There is sufficient shade around the school playing field for students to get some relief from the sun during breaks.
