3. *Please let us know if you no longer pay enough tax (but note that you may stop working but still be paying tax). If we claim in error, we shall refund the Inland Revenue.*
4. *Please tell us if you move house, change your name, or change your bank.*
5. *There is a leaflet, IR65 Gift Aid, available from your local tax office giving full information.*
6. *If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.*
