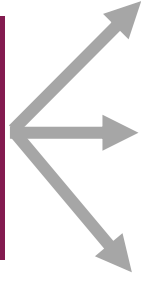


Behaviour Procedures

If you are poorly behaved / disruptive, you persistently infringe uniform rules, or are persistently late to class.



You will receive a lunchtime detention (Y7/8 on Weds/Fri, Y9-11 on Tues/Thurs) The teacher will record this in Schoolbase.



4 times = Friday night detention

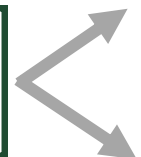
8 times = Saturday morning detention

12 times = Inset detention

If you are poorly organised e.g. forget books / equipment, leave books out etc.



Your teacher will talk to you after the lesson and record it in Schoolbase.



4 times = Monday lunchtime organisational coaching

8 times = Monday lunchtime organisational coaching for half a term

If you miss a homework or hand in an incomplete or substandard homework.



Your teacher will talk to you after the lesson and record it in Schoolbase.



4 times = After school homework support & work scrutiny with SMT for a week

8 times = After school homework support & work scrutiny with SMT for a half term

12 times = After school homework support & work scrutiny with SMT for a term

If you are caught with your mobile phone outside permitted time.



The member of staff will confiscate it and hand it to Mrs. Adams reception.



1st/2nd time - collect at the end of the day. Mrs Adams will inform parents

3rd time - as above plus a Friday night detention

4th time - parental meeting and phone ban

If your conduct during a lesson remains poor despite the teacher talking to you and imposing sanctions, as per the behaviour procedures, the teacher will call for a member of Senior Management and you will be removed from the lesson and there will be a sanction.

If you fail to attend a set punishment, misbehave during a punishment, or commit more serious misdemeanours, higher level sanctions such as Friday and Saturday detentions can be given immediately with approval from the Head or Deputy Head Teachers.

Internal and external exclusions will be given for intimidating or violent conduct, racism, continued bullying, severe rudeness to a member of staff, theft, possession or use of cigarettes, drugs or alcohol, or for persistently failing to meet expected standards despite all support and intervention.
