With our Year 6 pupils having missed out over the last two years on so many of the extra opportunities we offer at Claires Court, we wanted to organise some special activities that will give them a fantastic end to their time at Claires Court Junior Boys and Junior Girls.

These activities will be largely based outside and pupils should wear clothing and footwear that will be suitable for physical activities outside. Pupils will have received their leavers hoodies before the activities on Tuesday 29 June and may wish to wear them during the activity days. We would also ask that through this week pupils are supplied with a packed lunch so that both boys and girls are able to join each other for lunch outside.

Tuesday 29 June

A company called Outdoor Academy are joining us at the Junior Boys site to run a whole day of outward bound activities including:

- Mobile Climbing Wall
- Mobile Caving System
- Laser clay pigeon shooting
- Problem Solving Challenges

Monday 5 July

During the morning at Junior Boys all pupils will experience three different 1 hour workshops -

- Fencing
- Archery
- Paralympic Sports

The boys will be rehearsing for their end of term play during the afternoon.

Tuesday 6 July

During the morning the boys will be taking part in a Junk Percussion workshop, where they will be learning how to make music using household items and putting on a performance for other pupils in the school. The boys will be rehearsing for their end of term play during the afternoon.

Wednesday 7 July

During the morning at Junior Boys both boys and girls will be taking part in Forest School activities with the aim of promoting team building and communication skills.

In the afternoon the boys are going to be representing their house and competing in a Caribbean Cricket tournament. This is a fun and informal afternoon where the pupils are asked to dress up in loud shirts and shorts (grass skirts are optional). We do ask that all pupils wear

trainers (no flip flops please!). We aim to start this event at 1.15pm and finish at 5.00pm. We will finish the afternoon with a BBQ for pupils and parents. Thursday 8 July


