Make room for new books and return your overdue loans to the school library! We currently have a very large number of overdue library books on loan, so

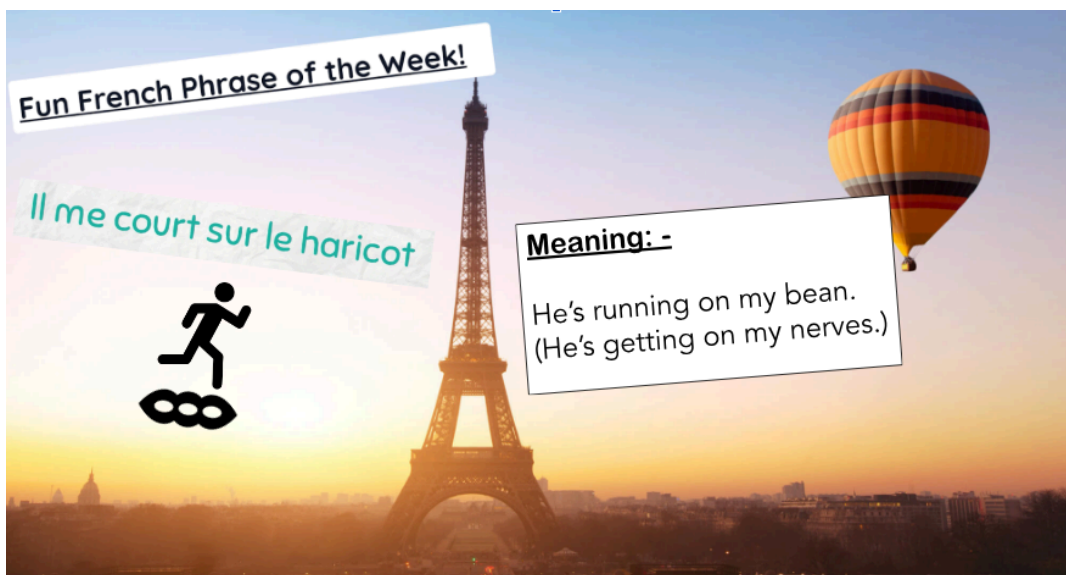
please renew or return any overdue books as soon as possible so everyone can read and enjoy them. Thank you for your support.
