Book Fair

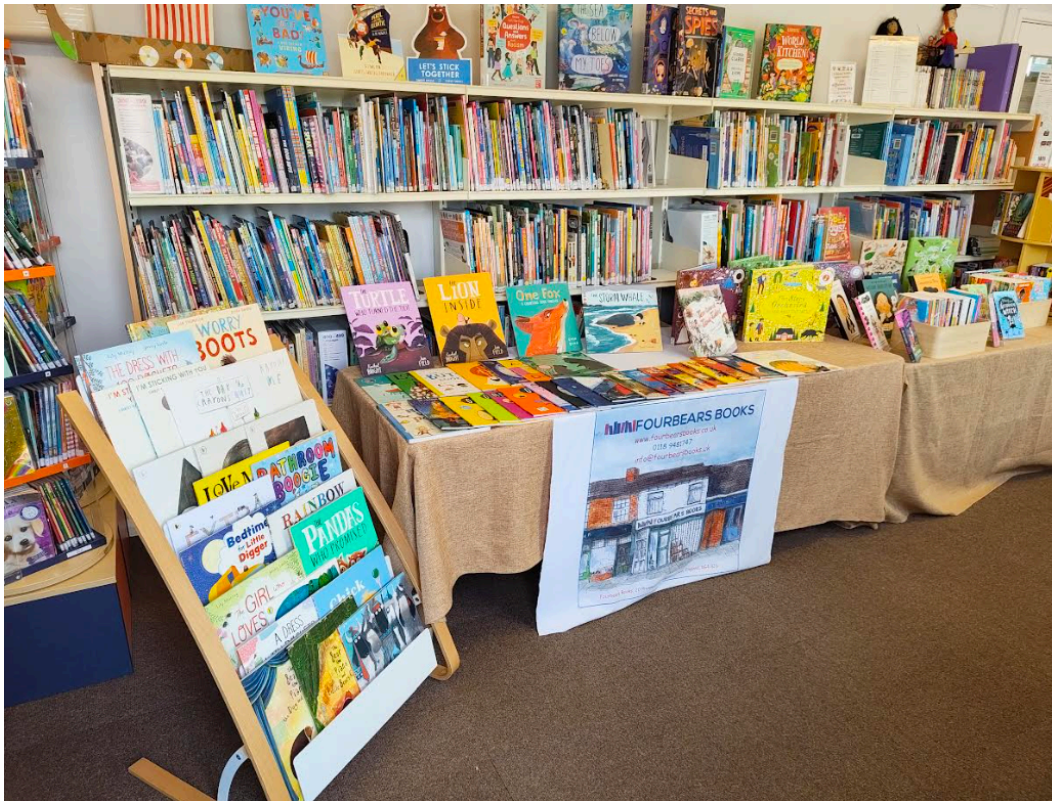
Thank you to all parents who supported The Claires Court / Fourbears Book Fair this year. If you're still interested in purchasing books, the link will remain on the website for another week.

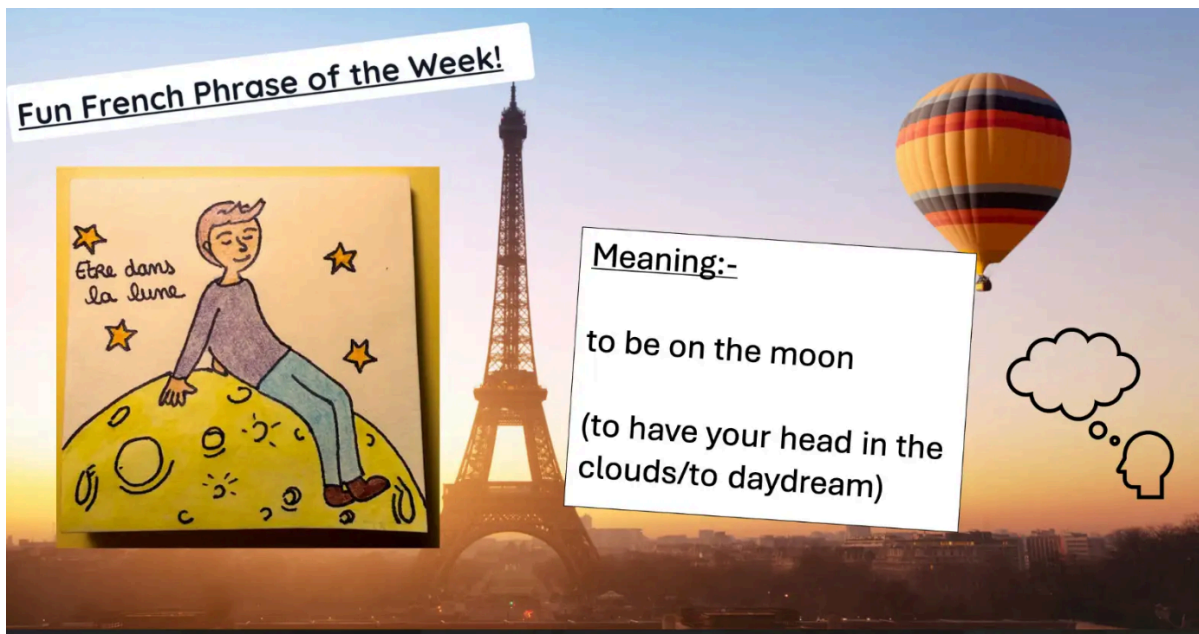
