**Thursday 20 August** - GCSE Results Day

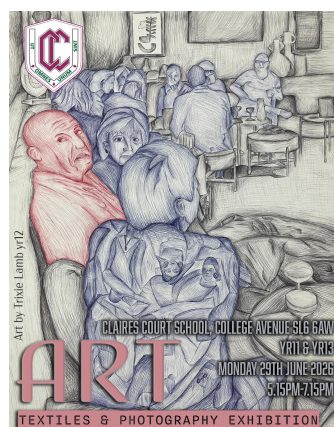
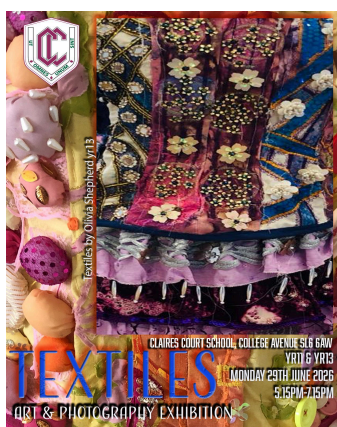
Please note although the school is open during the summer break the school office is not manned for the most part.

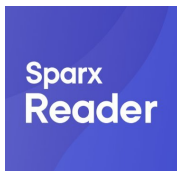
