Leaving School / Returning to School during the School Day

REMINDER - Parking on yellow lines and on the junctions

Despite continued requests, cars are still causing traffic problems on the junctions, in particular Ray Park Avenue. We want to ensure that traffic flows for everyone in this area so please **DO NOT STOP AND PARK UP** anywhere near the junction or the school and ask your son to walk further up as the waiting cars soon move.
