FROM THE OFFICE

PTA FIREWORKS Saturday 14 October 5pm - 9pm



Bar opens at 3.30pm for those coming to watch the Wales vs Argentina rugby, with the main gate opening at 5pm when stalls etc. will be up and running.

If you have purchased tickets in advance THANK YOU & these will have come home with your (oldest) child today or yesterday, so there is no need for you to queue at the gate, just show your wristband for quick entry. To ensure food is available may we kindly recommend you get this prior to 6.30pm.

If you haven't purchased yet, tickets will be available on the gate on the night (card payment accepted) although you will not be able to access food until 6.30pm.

COACH TRANSPORT w/c 16 October only

As previously confirmed in this <u>letter</u>, with the closure of Cookham Bridge from 16 October, we will be running all coaches (with the exception of Twyford and Windsor) at the earlier time of 4.15pm departing Senior Girls (College Special, Holmer Green) with the onward links homeward bound from Senior Boys at 4.30pm to allow for increased road congestion and thereby ensuring the day is not too long for our pupils and drivers.

All activities will continue to operate with the obligation for parents to collect from school if their specific school-home bus service is running early. Please note there are no changes to the school day timings or timings for activities this week.

TRANSPORT SCHEDULE after half term & changes to school day timings
After half term, the school day will finish ten minutes earlier at 3.50pm for all
Senior Girls and Sixth Form, with activities starting at 4pm and ending at
4.45pm. Students/pupils can be collected at these earlier times, or if parents are
unable to collect until later, children will be supervised at school. Those on
coaches home will be transferred at 4.50pm for onward coaches at Senior Boys.

The Holmer Green (College Special) coach will depart from College Avenue at 5.05pm. All other coaches, apart from the Twyford coach, will depart Senior Boys at 5.05pm Mondays to Thursdays and 4.30pm on Fridays and the last week of term. The Twyford coach will complete the late after activity link from Juniors to College and then to Senior Boys for the local pick-up families, and therefore will leave Senior Boys around 5.15pm.

There are some specific arrangements for individual passengers on the routes which Vectare will communicate directly to the families involved. These include for example, waiting on the other side of the road on the Bourne End pick-ups as the coaches are travelling out from Bourne End to the Marlow by-pass. Finlan Travel are collecting our Cookham passengers in the morning, and our own minibus drivers taking them home in the evening. This will be further explained in communication from Vectare.

Those pupils needing to wait at Senior Boys may of course do so, and we will look after them as usual from 5pm until parents collect circa 5.30pm Monday to Thursday and 4.30pm on Fridays.

We would like to reassure parents that each week we will review the arrangements in the light of the emerging traffic situation and adjust as best we can. Please find our <u>Chromebook Provision and Policy</u> as a reminder that pupils and parents are responsible for the chromebook that your daughter has been allocated, including any repairs/replacement due to damage/loss. Should you require the school to source you a new chromebook please email your daughter's form tutor to authorise the cost of approx. £250 being added to your fee invoice. If you decide to purchase your own replacement **chromebook** (please note other platforms/devices are not permitted in school e.g. laptops, apple as they are not compatible with our systems), you will need the Claires Court Google licence added to the chromebook at a cost of £35, again to be authorised by emailing your daughter's form tutor.

LEAVING SCHOOL / RETURNING TO SCHOOL DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

If you are collecting your daughter for an appointment during the school day, she should wait in reception at the allotted time. We do require parents/guardians to collect and sign your daughter out of school - we will not let a pupil leave school on their own to go to an appointment. Pupils are not permitted to wait outside or use their phones in reception. When your daughter returns to school, she must sign in at reception before going to lessons so that we know she is back in school.
