ISI Follow Up Visit

On Tuesday we received an unannounced Quality Assurance visit from the Independent Schools Inspectorate. We were expecting it this year, just maybe not in the second week back! Such visits are at the request of the Department for Education and this one specifically arose from aspects raised in our Inspection in November 2022. As a result of last year's recommendations, we had provided DfE with our timelines for improvement so that boys and girls could follow elements of Technology previously missing from their GCSE choices.

The focus for this visit was the educational provision, curriculum and management of the segregated provision for Senior Boys and Senior Girls. The Inspectors met with the Principals, Heads and Deputies of both sites, as well as teachers and pupils from Year 10. If your child was involved in these discussions please pass on both our thanks and from the inspectors too. They congratulated us on the quality of responses given from Year 10 and for the range of evidence we were able to provide at such short notice.

A report of their visit will be passed to DfE, who in turn will determine formally the outcomes of the visit. In the meantime, the feedback given to the Principals and Heads remains confidential, but we can say that both Mr Richards and I were very happy that the visit went well.
