Nick Winton Visit to School

Nick Winton, son of Sir Nicholas Winton, came to visit school this week and spoke to the Sixth Form. Sir Nicholas was known for organising the rescue of 669 children from Nazi-occupied Czechoslovakia during the 9 months before war broke out in 1939. The students were moved and inspired by Nick's stories of his Father:

"Listening to Nick Winton recount the story of his Father's achievements throughout his life was awe-inspiring and moving. It was inspiring to see how much difference one person with a determined attitude can make on the world." Claudia

OPTION 2 – MIXER TABLE FOR COUPLES/ SINGLESA perfect way to meet new parents!


