Flu Vaccination - please give or withhold consent as soon as possible

Please complete the <u>Consent for Flu Nasal Spray form</u> using school code BK110153B to either **give or withhold consent**. You will need your child's NHS number which can be found <u>here</u> if not known. If your child is unable to have the nasal flu vaccine due to the porcine gelatine, there is an alternative injectable flu vaccine - see <u>letter</u> for further information.



GENERAL INFORMATION

Sickness Absence

Please report all absences daily to the school office before 9.30am either via the <u>Report Portal</u> (accessible via the Parents page of our <u>website</u>), by email to <u>seniorboys@clairescourt.com</u> or 01628 327600.

Medical/Dental Appointments

Please notify the school office at least 24 hours prior to the appointment via email to seniorboys@clairescourt.com. We would also ask where possible that appointments are made outside of school hours or during school holidays.

Term Time Absence

Please see our <u>Attendance and Holidays in Term Time Policy</u> noting that absence for holidays is not encouraged during term time and will not normally be authorised for the first or last week of any term. If you do wish the headteacher to review a request please complete the <u>Online Holiday Request Form</u>.

Leaving School / Returning to School during the School Day

If you are collecting your son for an appointment during the school day, he should wait in reception at the allotted time. When you have arrived outside to pick him up, please call the school on 01628 327600 and we will sign him out and send him out to you. Pupils are not permitted to wait outside or use their phones in reception. When your son returns to school, he must sign in at reception before going to lessons so that we know he is back in school.

Illness and Games afternoons

If your son is unable to play sport, he is expected to accompany his year group to games and will be given an alternative role. Permission for non-attendance at games afternoons can only be signed off by the nurses (Medical-CC@clairescourt.net) or the Director of Sport, Mr Carter (sic@clairescourt.net).

Medication

Any medication should be handed into the school accompanied by the <u>CC Administration of Medicine Request Form</u> for nurses to administer.
