# Additional Sports Kit items - orders close 3 November

Claires Court Headmasters Run Club (CC - HMRC!) - starting after half term This run club is open to all staff and pupils, regardless of experience level. Whether you're a seasoned runner or just starting out, everyone is welcome to join.

- When: Every Friday morning 7.20am arrival for a 7.30am (sharp!) start Our first run will be Friday 8 November
- Where: Starting and finishing from outside the Senior Boys' reception
- **Distance:** Choose between a 3.5km (<u>Sheep</u>) or 5km route (<u>Double Sheep</u>)

The plan is to make sure we're back at school by 8am, so if you think a 5km run might take longer than 30mins, please opt for the 3.5km option.

Any pupils wishing to join will need to complete a consent form prior to their first run and this will be shared after half term. Staff tested the run this morning and are looking forward to the pupils joining them after half term.

Please complete the <u>Consent for Flu Nasal Spray form</u> using school code BK110153B to either **give or withhold consent**. You will need your child's NHS number which can be found <u>here</u> if not known. If your child is unable to have the nasal flu vaccine due to the porcine gelatine, there is an alternative injectable flu vaccine - see <u>letter</u> for further information.



# **Medical/Dental Appointments**

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# Leaving School / Returning to School during the School Day

If you are collecting your son for an appointment during the school day, he should wait in reception at the allotted time. When you have arrived outside to pick him up, please call the school on 01628 327600 and we will sign him out and send him out to you. Pupils are not permitted to wait outside or use their phones in reception. When your son returns to school, he must sign in at reception before going to lessons so that we know he is back in school.
