Stationery Requirements

Please ensure your daughter has the following equipment in school from the start of the summer term and check periodically that she still has all items as required, thank you.

- Glue stick, scissors
- Pens (black or blue for writing, plus purple for tests and green for corrections)
- Pencils, sharpener, eraser
- Ruler, geometry kit
- Scientific calculator (Year 8 summer term upwards)

Uniform Expectations

Please may we remind you and our pupils of our uniform expectations:

- Skirt to be on the knee.
- Hair to be of natural colour, and in a ponytail and off the face if below shoulder length.
- Pupils can wear up to two pairs of plain silver or gold stud earrings in each ear of maximum diameter 3mm, one per earlobe. Cartilage and nose piercings are not allowed. No further jewellery is permitted.
- Make up is not allowed in Year 7-9 and only light, discreet makeup is allowed in Years 10 and 11.
- Pupils may wear a Claires Court branded coat to and from school and also through the school day over their blazer through the colder months.
- If their coat is not a Claires Court branded coat then they can wear it to and from school but it must be put away in their locker once arrived.

Reporting Sickness/Medication/Holiday Requests

Sickness/Medical Appointments: Please report all absences daily to the school office before **9.30am** either via the Report Portal (accessible via the Parents page of our website), by email seniorgirls@clairescourt.com or 01628 327500. For medical appointments we would appreciate 24 hours notice, where possible, so that the office can inform the teaching staff if a pupil has to leave a lesson early or is missing in the morning due to an appointment.

Medication: Any medication must be handed into the school office together with a completed <u>Administration of Medicine Request Form</u>. Both will be given to the

nursing team to keep and administer.
