


Whole School Event - Cocktails and Canapés on Friday 6 June

Pupil Entrance/Exit Doors

Atrium Doors: Open 8am - 8.45am All senior girls should use this entrance and **not** the school office/reception door (this area can be quite busy with kitchen staff setting up for breakfast/morning break in the dining room and deliveries being received).

When the doors close at 8.45am the girls do have to come in via the office to sign in and may be considered as a late mark in the registers. All pupils using school transport are not marked late.

Office Hours: 8am - 5pm Please note if girls arrive early for a pre-arranged tutoring session/club the office may not be staffed until 7.45am so will not be able to enter the school until staff are there to buzz open the door.

End of Day: The Atrium doors will be open at **4pm** and then again at **5pm** and all girls must use this exit when leaving school at those times.

Reporting Sickness/Medication/Holiday Requests

Sickness/Medical Appointments: Please report all absences daily to the school office before **9.30am** either via the <u>Report Portal</u> (accessible via the Parents page of our <u>website</u>), by email <u>seniorgirls@clairescourt.com</u> or 01628 327500. For medical appointments we would appreciate 24 hours notice, where possible, so that the office can inform the teaching staff if a pupil has to leave a lesson early or is missing in the morning due to an appointment.

Medication: Any medication must be handed into the school office together with a completed <u>Administration of Medicine Request Form</u>. Both will be given to the nursing team to keep and administer.
