Library Books

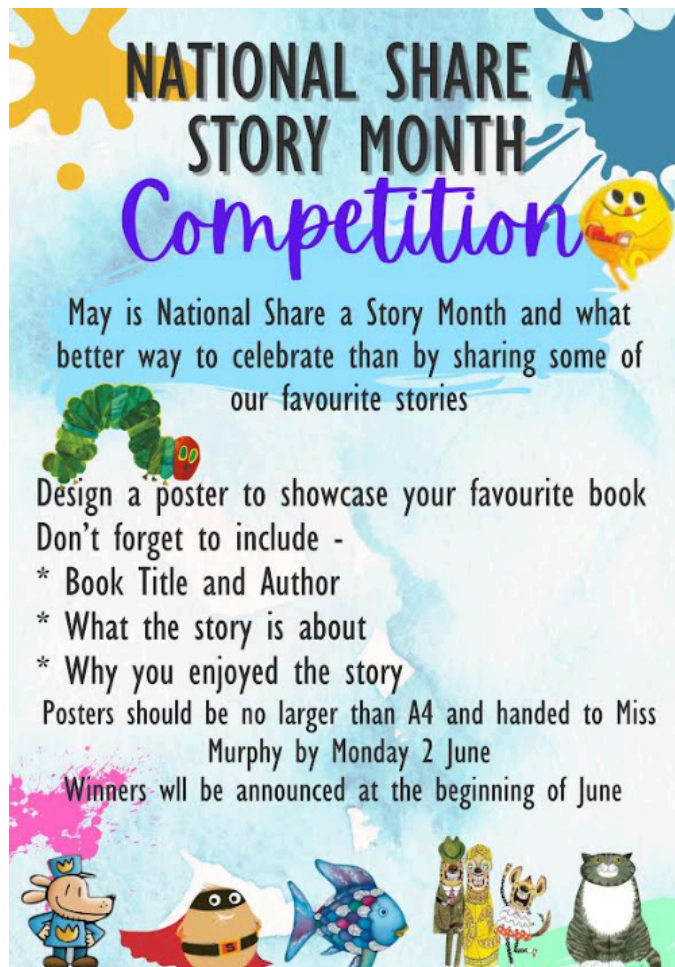
All children Years 3 - 6 are expected to have a reading book on them on the day of their Library session. This can be a Library book or a book from home and can be Fiction or Nonfiction.
