The Year 10 Parents Evening will be held in school on Wednesday 2 July. Discussions will focus on your son's preparation for the exams and learnings from that. Appointments will be bookable in advance via Schoolcloud and bookings will open 7am Thursday 26 June and close Tuesday 1 July at 9am. Please opt to book manually so you can leave appropriate 'travel time' gaps between English, Maths and Science appointments which will be in the Maths Block classrooms (rooms 1-8) and all other subjects based in the Sports Hall. Science appointments will be ten minutes and you will be allocated one teacher who will cover all three Sciences and all other subject appointments will be five minutes. Parking will be available in school after 5.40pm when all the school coaches will have safely departed the site. On arrival please sign in at the Sports Hall, where refreshments will be available.


YEAR 11 ONLY
