End of Day Collections

Parents/Visitors are **not permitted on site during the school day** unless authorised by the School Office. For safeguarding purposes, we must be aware of who is on site at all times. If you need to collect your child early, please inform the office in advance and collect your child via the main entrance at the front of the school. Please ensure that anyone collecting your child, such as grandparents, is also aware of this procedure.

For club pickups, the same process applies: you must notify the office if you are collecting your child early and arrive via the school office. If collecting at the usual time, please avoid arriving before 5pm.

Additional Reminders

If a pupil arrives late, they must be dropped off at the front of the school and signed in at the office. Please note that, for safeguarding reasons, parents are not permitted to accompany pupils to the lockers.

Coach Movement on Site – Please Give Way and Drive Safely

When you see the coach entering or exiting the site, please <u>give way</u> to avoid causing any blockages or delays to its onward journey, as coaches are large vehicles that require ample space to manoeuvre. They will be using the designated bus lane located on the drive, which is on the opposite side of the road. If you see a coach moving up or down the drive, please move to the other lane when it is safe to do so and do not attempt to overtake the coach, as this poses a risk to the safety of staff, pupils, and parents.
