Claires Court will participate in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead's (RBWM) <u>Smartphone Free Schools Consortium</u>. #### **U18 Tennis Boys Secure Third in the UK!**

A massive congratulations to our U18 tennis boys who achieved a superb 3rd place in the UK at the recent National Finals in Nottingham! This is a tremendous result and something we are incredibly proud to celebrate.

After four days of hard-fought competition in the year's hottest temperatures, our squad—Rhys (Year 13), Max (Year 13), Danny, Murray, Harry Co, Harry Ca, and Theo—showed exceptional skill and resilience. They only lost to the eventual winners in this, the most prestigious tennis competition on the school calendar.

The boys convincingly beat Millfield to secure their third-place finish, having previously knocked out the 4th seeds in an earlier round. We are incredibly proud of their achievements, and their success highlights the strength of our partnership with the Delgado & Lee Tennis Academy, where all these players train. Congratulations, boys—what an accomplishment!
