Road Safety Reminder – College Avenue Site

We'd like to remind all parents and carers to please take extra care when dropping off and collecting children at the College Avenue site.

We have noticed several potentially dangerous situations recently, including:

- Vehicles using the entrance as an exit
- Children running across the car park or out through the gate toward the road
- Children running ahead of adults while using the one way system between the front car park and the coach bays

For everyone's safety, especially our children's, please ensure you:

- **Use the designated entry and exit points correctly**
- **Keep your child close to you at all times**
- **Avoid letting children run ahead in busy traffic areas**
- **Always bolt the nursery gate when entering and leaving**
