#### This week at Nursery...

Learning new vocabulary is occurring all the time in the Nursery and this week the children have been learning what it means for an animal to be nocturnal, diurnal and crepuscular.

Miss Green has played some fun games where she has described an animal and its habits and the children have had to decide which animal she is talking about. She has also played for them the noises which certain animals make. That was tricky!!!

I enjoyed some time in the classroom too, playing a number game. Amazing that so many can recognise their numbers to five and some can recognise beyond.



## <u>PE</u>

Calculated risks are important in the Early Years. It is important for building essential life skills such as resilience, problem solving, independence and confidence. By allowing children to navigate challenges in a safe environment, adults help them to learn to assess and manage risks, cope with setbacks, and develop crucial physical coordination and body awareness.

During their weekly PE lessons and Forest School, Miss Reeves and the nursery staff are consistently encouraging these skills.





## **Forest School**

With the temperature dropping so drastically this week, a lot of the children really struggled. This is mainly due to clothing. Please can we ask that all children are wearing the following, even if it is not uniform:

- thick trousers/leggings
- multiple warm layers
- thick, winter-style coat or snow suit
- thick socks
- warm waterproof gloves which are easily put on and which children can still manage tasks whilst wearing.
- hat and scarf

We will then remove these layers and warm clothing when they come back for the afternoon. This week, Mr P's objective was to try and get the children to create channels to make a stream. They used spades, sticks and anything else they could find to dig at the soil.



**Bumble Bees**Tea with the Gruffalo anyone?




The children love the story of The Gruffalo and The Gruffalo's Child and this week have been using their amazing language and vocabulary to recreate the stories.


