- Year 9 parents and boys are invited into school next Thursday to meet with subject teachers (apart from History, see above). You do not need to book appointments as all the teachers will be based in the Sports Hall so you can decide who to see on the night.
- In addition to current subject teachers, Mrs Frost, Mr Beck, and Mr Bolton will also be present representing Food Preparation and Nutrition, Business Studies and Physical Education if you have any questions about studying those subjects at GCSE level.
- For Science you will be allocated one teacher to speak to about all three Sciences to save you seeing separately Biology, Chemistry and Physics teachers. Boys will be aware of their allocated Science teacher as this will have been shared in Google Classroom.
- The coaches should have departed by **5.30pm so please feel free to park in school** after that time, but not before.
- Your son can remain at school and you can meet up with him when you arrive. On arrival at school please make your way to the sport hall and sign in there where refreshments will be available.
- We will email you the GCSE Options Form in advance of the evening and ask that you please complete that by Monday 19 February.

Leaving School / Returning to School during the School Day

If you are collecting your son for an appointment during the school day, he should wait in reception at the allotted time. When you have arrived outside to pick him up, please call the school on 01628 327600 and we will sign him out and send him out to you. Pupils are not permitted to wait outside or use their phones in reception. When your son returns to school, he must sign in at reception before going to lessons so that we know he is back in school.

Medication

Any medication should be handed into the school accompanied with the <u>CC Administration of</u> <u>Medicine Request Form</u> for nurses to administer.

Parking near School

Please do not stop on the double yellow lines at the crossroads of Ray Park Avenue and Ray Mill Road East, or on the zig zags outside school. Pupils are not permitted to use their mobile phone during the school day. Years 7 and 8 will be required to hand their mobile into their Form Tutor during morning registration. Pupils in other year groups should lock their mobile securely in their locker or hand it in to Mrs Tarr before registration. If boys need to contact home during the day for any reason, they should do so via the school office or nurses depending on the reason for contact.
