Dress *GUIDANCE*

Formal Business Mondays



Formal business dress is worn on Mondays and to all significant School events including Speech Day, Carol Service, Commemoration Day Service, and the Year 12 Celebration. A suit (matching jacket and trousers) with a shirt and tie with smart business shoes should be worn or a suit (matching jacket and trousers/skirt/dress of mid-thigh length) with collared blouse and smart business shoes to be worn. Shoulders must be covered.

Dress *GUIDANCE*

Business Casual
Tuesdays - Fridays



Casual business dress can be worn Tuesday to Friday which comprises of chinos, a blazer, plain polo shirt (collared) and smart business shoes (no trainers or Ugg boots) with the option to wear a shirt and team tie on match days.

Or

A combination of skirt/dress (mid-thigh length only), or trousers with a jacket (does not need to match) with smart business shoes is the alternative.

NB. Shoulders and midribs must be covered e.g. no strappy/off the shoulder/crop tops. Hoodies, jeans and tracksuits (trousers or sweatshirts) are not classed as casual business dress and therefore cannot be worn.
